*Please sing after the second decade:*

In heaven the blessed, your glory proclaim  
On earth we, your children, invoke your sweet name.  
Ave, Ave, Ave Maria! Ave, Ave, Maria!

***The Third Joyful Mystery is the Birth of Our Lord***

She gave birth to her first-born Son and wrapped Him in swaddling clothes and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. (Luke 2:6-7)

Fruit of the Mystery: Poverty

*Please sing after the third decade:*

We pray you, O Mother, may God's will be done  
We pray for His glory; may His Kingdom come.  
Ave, Ave, Ave Maria! Ave, Ave, Maria!

***The fourth Joyful Mystery is the Presentation***

When the day came to purify them according to the law of Moses, the couple brought Him up to Jerusalem so that He could be presented to the Lord, for it is written in the law of the Lord, "Every first-born male shall be consecrated to the Lord." (Luke 2:22-23)

Fruit of the Mystery: Obedience

*Please sing after the fourth decade:*

We pray for our Mother, the Church upon earth  
And bless, holy Mary, the land of our birth.  
Ave, Ave, Ave Maria! Ave, Ave, Maria!

***The fifth Joyful Mystery is the Finding of the Child Jesus in the Temple***

On the third day they came upon Him in the temple sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. (Luke 2:46)

Fruit of the Mystery: Joy in Finding Jesus

*Please sing after the fifth decade:*

Immaculate Mary, your praises we sing  
Who reigns now with Jesus, our redeemer and King.

**Hail, Holy Queen**

Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness, and our hope.
